Here are the photos. I caught three fish using a dollar store butterfly net while accompanied with my four year old daughter Erin. I found the fish at the roots of a tree that was located just west of the footbridge linking Columbia Forest to Clair Hills subdivision.

To find the footbridge, drive to the end of the Columbia Forest Blvd's turn around and you'll see the trail entrance by the parkette. Go in and turn left. You'll find the footbridge on the other side of the hill. From the bridge, look up the creek you'll see the large fallen tree. The fish are at the roots. I took a photo of the creek from the location where I found the fish.
