In response to your May 4, 2010 request, submitted under the <u>Freedom of Information and</u> Protection of Privacy Act (the Act), for access to:

"In February 2010, the Ministry of Natural Resources published a report titled "The State of Aggregate Resources in Ontario Study" (SAROS). On page 4 of the report it gives reference to six papers titled:

1) The Value of Aggregates

2) Aggregate Consumption and Demand

3) Reuse and Recycling

4) Aggregate Reserves in Existing Operations

5) Future Aggregate Availability and Alternative Analysis

6) Rehabilitation.

I would like copies of these 6 papers."

I have decided to deny access to these records under section 22 of the Act. This provision applies to these record(s) because they are due to be published in the very near future. It is the Ministry's intention to publish the six SAROS reports you have requested before August 1st, 2010; these reports will be published on the MNR's website at www.ontario.ca/aggregates under the 'The State of the Aggregate Resource in Ontario Study' section on or before the above-noted date.
