**Re: Westside Subdivisions**

As Solicitor for the City of Waterloo, I have been instructed to respond to your November 22<sup>nd</sup> emails to Council Members, City & Regional Staff and others.

Notwithstanding your objections, the Westside residential subdivisions were approved by the Regional Municipality of Waterloo.

Despite your Appeal, the Ontario Municipal Board determined that residential development is appropriate on these lands and approved the subdivisions with no substantial change to the Region's approvals. The Ontario Municipal Board granted you no further role or rights with respect to these subdivisions.

I have been instructed to inform you that unfounded statements and factual distortions will not curtail the orderly and proper development of the Westside Residential subdivisions. The subdivisions will proceed. The approved conditions are being carried out under the competent supervision of qualified experts, who understand the multi-faceted nature of these developments.


We respectfully suggest that you seek legal advice before you harass City Staff and intentionally libel people who value their professional reputations. If you continue to make unfounded statements and factual distortions, the City and/or the affected people may seek legal recourse against yourself or others who suggest that they do not carry out their duties in a responsible and efficient manner.

The foregoing is the City's final written response to your emails, and it has no intention to further debate these issues with you, by email or otherwise.

Please govern yourself accordingly.
