PROTECT YOUR WATER and FOOD HIGHLAND HAS FILED ITS MEGA QUARRY APPLICATION

- <u>Highland Companies has officially filed</u> a 3,000 page application for their 2,400 acre 200 foot deep open pit limestone mine. The process is legislated and you must know of timelines and deadlines for submissions.

ACTION REQUIRED NOW

- Letters of objection to the proposal are urgently needed-attend the April 2 meeting for information on this process
- Letters must be signed and contain your return mailing address and be mailed or delivered to both the Ministry of Natural Resources, 2284 Nursery Road, Midhurst Ontario LOL 1X0 AND The Highland Companies, Box 377, Shelburne, ON L0N 1S0
- Letters must be received by both the MNR and Highlands by April 26, 2011. Easter weekend is on April 22- 25 and mail will not move on these days so, to be safe, consider April 21st as the deadline.

- Ensure everyone in your household writes their own letter and encourage your neighbours and friends to write letters as well

- File an objection on the EBR at this link regarding the legislative timing: <u>www.ebr.gov.on.ca/ERS-WEB-</u> <u>External/displaynoticecontent.do?noticeId=MTEyNTY2&statusId=MTY4ODI5&language=en</u> Suggested wording: There are more than 3,000 pages of reports and studies on this proposal to review with a 45 day time limit. The public, agencies, Ministries and approval authorities could not realistically do their due diligence and provide comments/objections within these time frames. At minimum, the time frame for comments must be extended to at least 6 months.

SUMMARY OF HIGHLANDS PROPOSAL – according to their material and at full operational capacity

- 2,400 acre 200 foot below the water table open pit limestone mine in stages
- 7,200 plus trucks a day-3,600 in and 3,600 out (300 trucks per HOUR) but has no analysis on the greenhouse gas emissions, impact on tourism corridors, school bus routes or traffic safety
- large rail operation involving 16 hours of crossing time per day at every crossing
- DAILY water usage of 600 million litres which equates to the same amount of water that 25% of the entire population of Ontario uses DAILY
- 16 pumps operating 24/7 no analysis on cost to run the pumps after the mine is exhausted and has been "rehabilitated to agriculture"
- Standing water from the quarry to be re-injected to wells into our aquifer
- 365 days a year blasting except on stat holidays-no analysis of the potential impact of dust on surrounding crops, existing business and farming operations with livestock and animals
- promise of 400 jobs, but not all are local no analysis of the loss of existing jobs
- "plans" show rehabilitation, but the Minister of Natural Resources advised the Mayor and Deputy of the Township of Melancthon in February 2011: ""...this will not be going back to agriculture, but maybe you could get a nice golf course".
