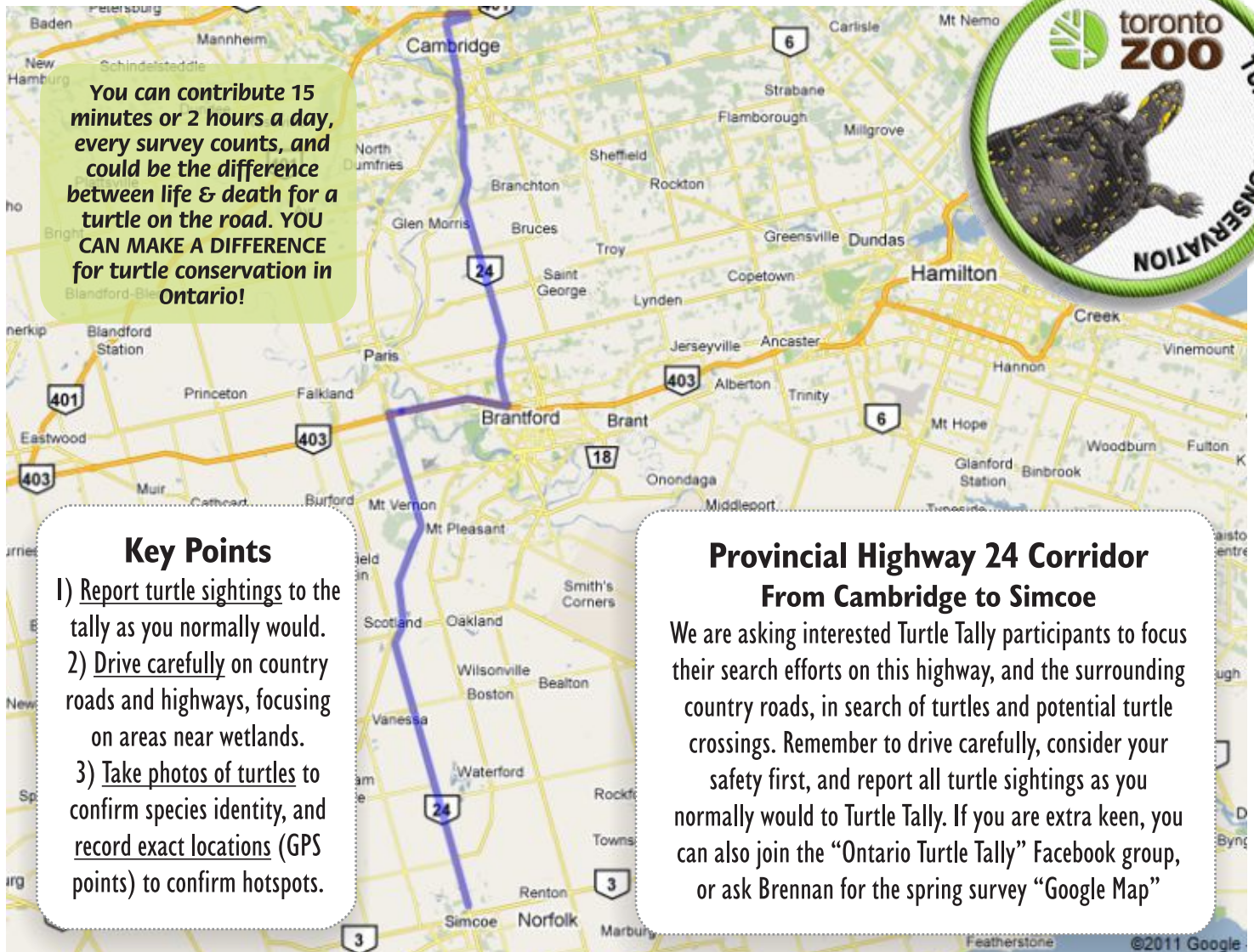


Ontario Turtle Tally Team
