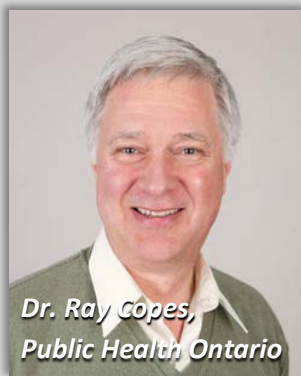
Dear Colleagues,

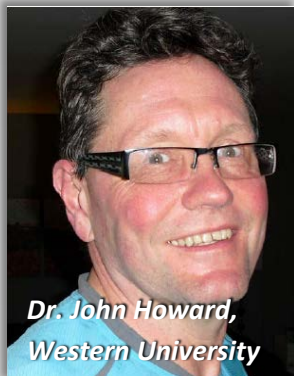

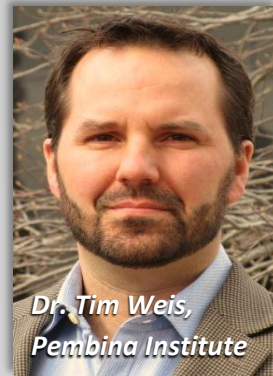
