Site 1: Boothby Farm - Tallgrass Prairie Buffer, Reforestation, & Wetland Creation

A tallgrass prairie buffer was established around a deep valley to prevent erosion and runoff from the adjacent agricultural field, while also providing sediment and nutrient filtration, wildlife habitat, and shading to lower water temperatures. *Speaker: Kathryn Boothby (landowner)*

Site 2: Vermeersch Farm – Tallgrass Prairie with Forbs

A tallgrass prairie ecosystem was established to support broad ecosystem services including pollination, climate regulation and carbon sequestration, increased soil health, regeneration of important wildlife habitat and increased biological diversity.

This property features several project areas, including reforestation and wetland creation within a lower agricultural field along Big Creek, which contribute to a unique and valuable wildlife corridor on the property. *Speakers: Kristyn Richardson (Long Point Basin Land Trust) and Paul Gagnon (Long Point Region Conservation Authority).*

Site 4: Ruppert Farm – Reforestation

Trees were planted on a marginal sandy field to stabilize soils, converting an area of land which offered poor agricultural production into a healthy forest habitat.
