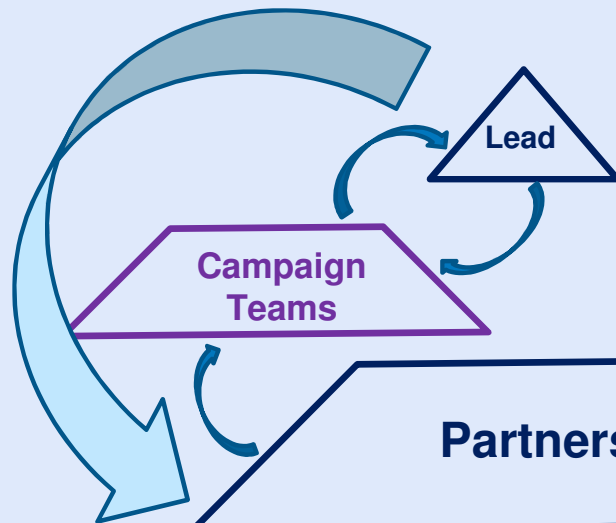


Organizational & Implementation Structure of the Coalition of Ontario Watershed Alliances



COWA will be managed by the Ontario Headwaters institute, including the recruitment of Partners and Campaign Teams wanting to work on a provincial or local issues, delivering submissions, petitions, and community engagement.

Campaign Teams will develop and/or comment or draft text for COWA submissions, petitions, and community engagement. Campaign Teams shall act as short-term steering committees on issues of mutual concern, spreading the load of a mid- to long-term steering committee amongst the Partners.

Partners will form the backbone of the Alliance and will be listed on the COWA website. In addition to receiving regular communications, Partners can join a Campaign Team working on an issue of common concern. In general, Partners shall support but are not obligated to support COWA submissions, petitions, or community actions.

COWA will invite people and groups that do not have the capacity to participate on Campaign Teams but wish to help Ontario better address water security to become Supporters by signing up on Mailchimp. Supporters will not be listed on the Alliance website but will receive updates and be asked to support COWA campaigns.
