



Halton Hills Town Hall: Atura Gas Plant Expansion Proposal

Hear the evidence – Your voice can make the difference

Attend this interactive virtual Town Hall to learn about the proposed new gas plant in Halton Hills and how you can take action. This will have major adverse impacts on public health, affordability/cost of living, climate change and the economy within and beyond your community. Ontario Power Generation (OPG) wants to build a new polluting fossil fuel gas plant at the existing Halton Hills power plant near the 401 and Sixth Line. This plant is already the largest greenhouse gas polluter in Halton, and third largest in the GTA. It also emits other health harming toxic air pollutants which will most impact Halton Hills, Milton, Meadowvale West and surrounding communities. The new plant will cost hundreds of millions of tax dollars that should be spent on clean energy. Our provincial government is further incentivizing gas companies by offering to *continue paying them our tax dollars even if the plant is shut down* in a few years by upcoming federal Clean Electricity Regulations.

Experts and local co-hosts will be available to discuss the issues, alternative solutions, and how you can take action to protect your community. Bring your questions for the interactive Q+A to follow.

Residents of Greater Napanee and surroundings are also invited to attend due to the simultaneous proposal by OPG for another even larger gas plant expansion at the Napanee Generating Station tentatively going to Council vote Nov 28, 2023.
