If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Regional Municipality of Waterloo to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Wilmot before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Wilmot before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Regional Municipality of Waterloo in respect of the proposed official plan amendment, you must make a written request to the Regional Municipality of Waterloo, 150 Frederick Street, Kitchener, ON N2G 4J3.

Appeal with respect to Zone Change Application

If a person or public body did not make oral submissions at the public meeting, or make written submissions to the Township of Wilmot before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of Township of Wilmot Council to the Ontario Land Tribunal.

If a person or public body did not make oral submissions at the public meeting, or make written submissions to the Township of Wilmot before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
