

1) Get in Car.

- 2) Take 401 Westbound if you are coming from Toronto (Westbound is towards London not Kingston).
- 3) After passing Cambridge, get off at Hwy #8 (to Kitchener and Waterloo).
- 4) Take Hwy #8 to Hwy #86 North (marked to Waterloo).
- 5) After about 5 kilometers exit at King Street, Waterloo (about the 5th exit after getting onto the Hwy 86 Expressway).
- 6) Proceed South (turn left) onto King Street about 1 kilometre to Columbia Street (there's a McDonalds Restaurant at the intersection).
- 7) Turn right onto Columbia St.and proceed about 6 kilometres until Erbsville Road (you drive through the suburbs and the University of Waterloo).
- 8) At the Columbia Street and Erbsville Road intersection turn right (you are now going North).
- 9) Follow Erbsville Road about 2 kilometres to the village of Erbsville and turn left (West) onto Conservation Drive at the flashing yellow light.
- 10) Follow Conservation Drive through the forest until the road ends in about 2 kilometres.
- 11) Turn right onto The Wilmot Line (North). You will now be travelling uphill on a gravel road.
- 12) Turn left at the first road you come to. You will now be travelling West on Cedar Grove Road.
- 13) Follow Cedar Grove Road for about 1 kilometre until you come down a big hill. The township road will dead end at the bottom of this hill and straight ahead will be a driveway marked private. This is the start of my driveway and property.
- 14) Follow the driveway about 300 metres to a "Y" junction and go right down the branch marked "The Lane". You will pass a large brown house on the left this is Mr. & Mrs. Henderson my next door neighbours. They have a loud dog called Copper who will bark but will not bite.
- 15) I'm the next house, a small brown one storey house with a double garage on the left side and a split rail fence at the front.
- 16) Park and get out of the car.
