

Join our 'crowd-raising' campaign from May 1-15, 2014 to help us JUMPSTART Waterloo Region's bikeshare!

Community Access Bikeshare (CAB) <u>www.theworkingcentre.org/cab</u> is Waterloo Region's newest start-up, communitybased bikeshare. CAB members access easy-to-ride bikes located at convenient stations in Kitchener and Waterloo from Apr-Nov. Members pay a one-time fee of \$40; no overage fees!

Bikeshares help to reduce traffic congestion, improve air quality, drive economic development, build bike culture and motivate people to use cycling as a great active transportation alternative.

We launched our bikeshare in 2013 – now it's time to make our system bigger and better: we need to add more stations, invite more members and attract super advertisers and sponsors who believe in what we're doing.

What is crowd-raising?

You've likely heard the word 'crowdfunding', where large amounts of people contribute small amounts of money to help move a project forward.

Crowd-raising describes what we want to do for our bikeshare:

- raise volunteer support
- raise new bikeshare members
- raise awareness about bikesharing
- raise funds for our bikeshare!

How will the crowd-raising campaign work?

The crowd-raising campaign will take place from May 1-15, 2014. Social and traditional media releases about the campaign will be sent out prior to the start of the campaign.

We are inviting you to be a campaign 'champion' to help us spread the word about the campaign to your networks by sending out information about 4-5 times from May 1-15. You will be given sample emails, tweets, blog entries and photos to distribute to your networks, inviting people to:

- join our CAB Announce email list
- buy a bikeshare membership for themselves or someone else
- talk about the bikeshare on their favourite social media platform
- volunteer with Community Access Bikeshare
- donate money to the bikeshare, advertise or sponsor the bikeshare program

Each day of the campaign we'll be promoting and thanking our crowd-raising campaign champions through mentions on our Twitter feed, in our e-list emails and on our campaign landing page.
