

Workshop in a Box

Get involved in shaping Waterloo Region's Community Climate Adaptation Plan!

How vulnerable are you and your organization to the impacts of climate change?

The workshop in a box is intended to collect information on how your organization is currently or could be impacted by changes in local climate conditions. Your responses to this activity will help the Region of Waterloo identify priority areas for further study during the creation of the Community Climate Adaptation Plan.

1 What is included?



Each workshop in a box contains all of the materials you will need to conduct a vulnerability assessment activity within your organization for your stakeholders; such as:

- Letter to introduce workshop purpose, objectives, and concepts
- One-page fact sheet on projected climate changes within Waterloo Region
- Climate Change Vulnerability 101 overview document
- Facilitator's guide
- Table worksheets
- Note taking form for facilitators/note takers
- PowerPoint presentation
- Reporting template

2 Who can use it?

Anyone! The workshop in a box is applicable to a wide variety of organizations that have engaged and interested stakeholders. The minimum number of participant's needed is 6.



3 How can it be helpful?

The workshop in a box is a great way to begin having a climate conversation by considering the impacts of climate change on your organization. It is also a creative way to engage your employees, members, and/or stakeholders in this important conversation. Its also an opportunity for you to contribute your organization's perspectives on what impacts should be a priority for Waterloo Region as they work to develop a community-wide Climate Adaptation Plan.

4 What is the time commitment?

Conducting the vulnerability assessment exercise can range anywhere from 2 - 4 hours, depending on the number of impacts you assess. Additional time will be needed for planning the workshop, and filling out the reporting framework with your results.
